

REVISED DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR Ph.D. (2019-22) BATCH

With reference to the council letter issued vide F.No. Edu.1-3/2019-Exam Cell, dated 3rd May, 2019 and proceedings of the meeting held at the council dated 22nd May, 2019, regarding 10% increase of EWS seats across the disciplines offered at ICAR-CIFE Mumbai, Ph.D. (2019-22) batch seats have been revised.

- Seats for Divyang will be allotted horizontally against the category (Gen/SC/ST/OBC) to which they belong as per Govt. of India rules.
- Candidates who had already applied for Ph.D. for the academic year 2019-2020 at ICAR-CIFE, Mumbai and wants to claim against **EWS quota** shall have to submit the certificate given in the prescribed format (given in the link below) **latest by 21st August, 2019**, otherwise his/her candidature against EWS quota will not be considered.
