

ICAR CIFE organized 3- day training programme on “Captive Breeding Potential of Naghavang, *Semiplotus modestus*: The state fish of Mizoram” at Lunglei, Mizoram

A 3-day training programme on “Captive Breeding Potential of Naghavang, *Semiplotus modestus*: The state fish of Mizoram” was organized by ICAR- Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), Mumbai in collaboration of Department of Fisheries, Lunglei, Mizoram under NEH scheme of CIFE during 10-12 February 2026. The programme was inaugurated in presence of Mrs. Christina Lalramchhani, District Fisheries Development Officer, Mrs. Jacinta Laltanpuii, Executive Engineer, Irrigation & Water Resources Department, and Mr. Lalthakima, District Horticulture Officer.

There are 55 farmers (48 males and 7 females) attended this training programme. During the training programme different aspects of fish breeding, feed and feeding management, and water quality management were covered. Dr. Prem Kumar, Principal Scientist from ICAR -CIFE briefed about the biology and breeding potential of *S. modestus*, and demonstrated the captive breeding of common carp.

The programme concluded with certificate distribution and vote of thanks was proposed by Mr. Lalruatfela Chhangte, Fisheries Extension Officer.
